

## 1.4 TEN, MORE OR LESS

**Objective:** Child travelling on all fours towards scattered number cards, some blank (face down). A written note with number sentences on, such as  $73 > 37$ , and  $37$

### Instructions

1. You need some space at home or outside to move around and collect cards
2. Make a set of 0-9 number cards and scatter them around the room face down
3. Move quickly on all fours to collect two digit cards, e.g. 1 and 5
4. Make them into two 2-digit numbers (15 and 51 in this example)
5. Tell someone what number is ten more and ten less than each of the two numbers (25 and 5, 61 and 41)
6. Collect two more cards and repeat. Continue until all 10 cards have been used
7. Write down all the 2-digit numbers you made, plus the ten more and ten less numbers, in order from smallest to biggest. This should be 15 numbers in all!

### Challenge

Can you repeat the task but complete it in a quicker time?
