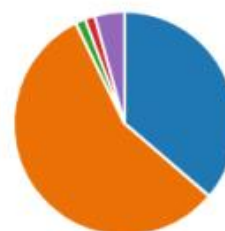

RE/SATS

In Year 6 there is a definite focus in getting children ready for the SATs, we want our children to do the very best that they can and I make no apologies for putting in extra lessons/tuition for the children so that they can do just that. Our results are phenomenal and Mrs Hines is a fabulous teacher who knows the learning well in Year 6. It is a fine balance between making sure our children are prepared and raising any anxiety levels in the class. We will keep an eye on this.

For RE we follow the Hampshire 'Living Difference' syllabus and within that concepts which are then linked in a religious context. Throughout KS1 it is Christianity and Jewish religions, Christianity and Hindu and Christianity and Islam.
