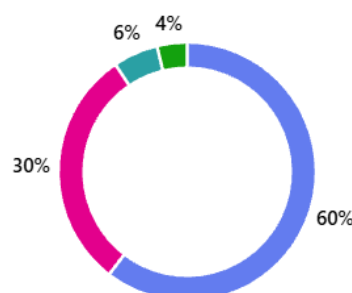

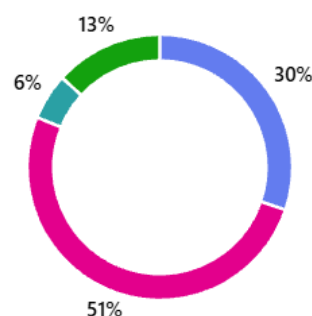

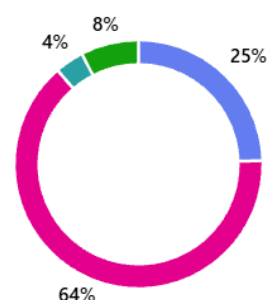

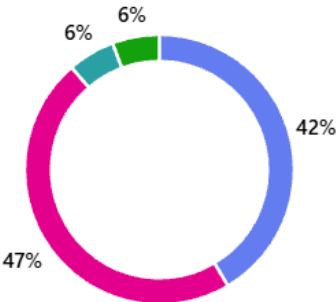

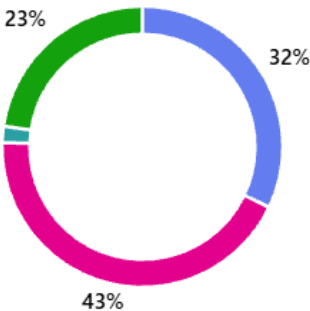

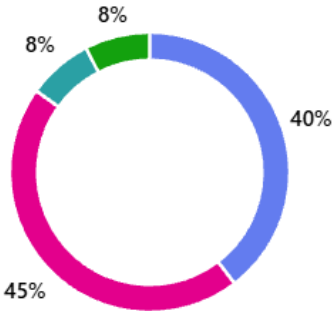

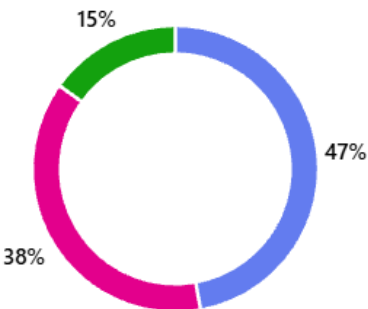

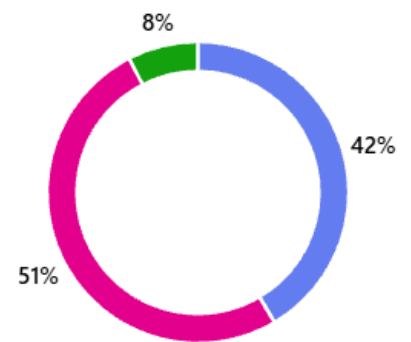

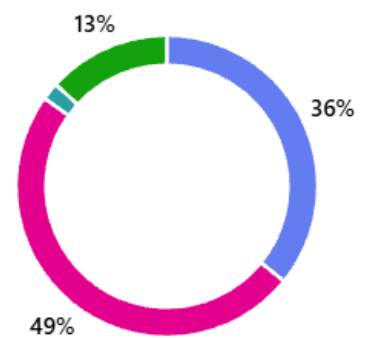

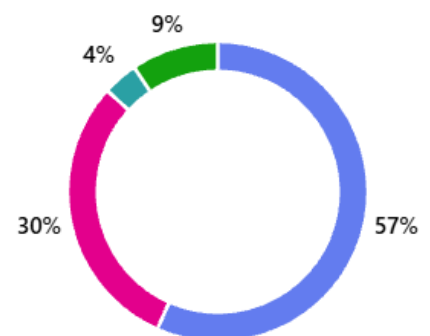

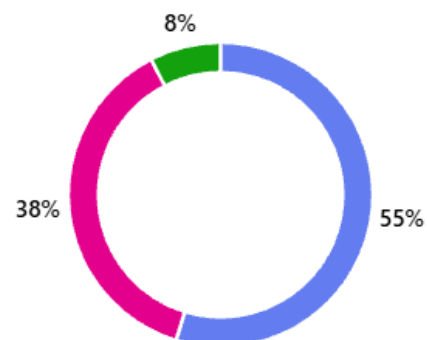

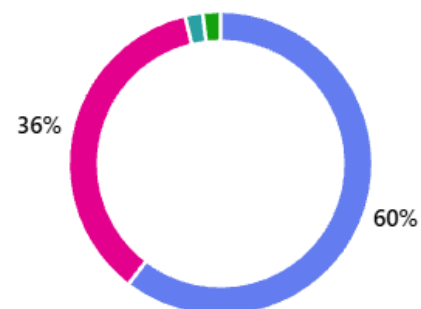

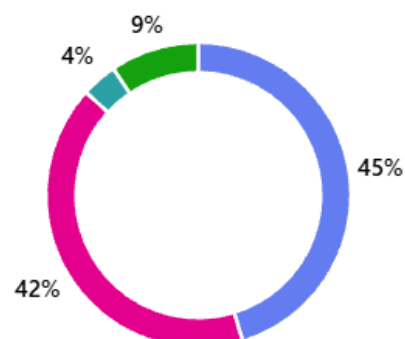

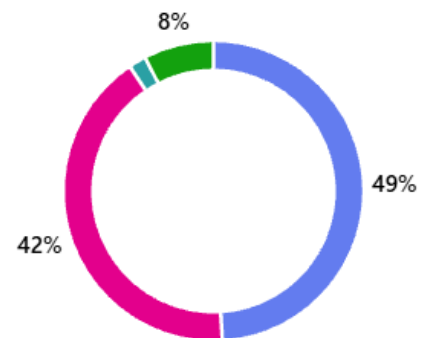

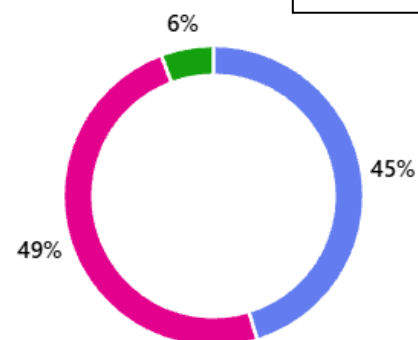

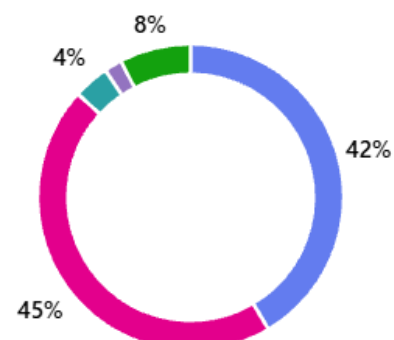

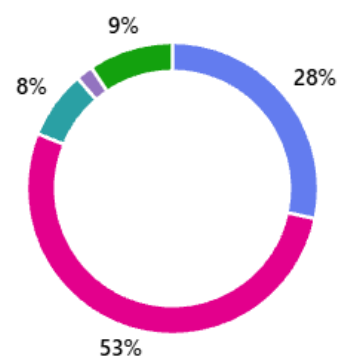

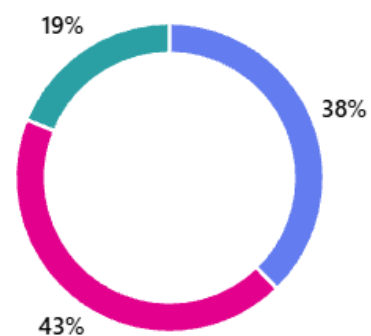

Parents' own comments and suggestions

Every single member of staff work really hard here to ensure all children have a good experience at our school and they really enjoy looking at the comments that you all write – it really does make our day, thank you!

Thank you to all parents and carers who took the time to complete our Parent View survey and provide additional comments. The responses are overwhelmingly positive about Sheet Primary School, with parents highlighting the care, commitment and passion of staff, the support their children receive and the strong sense of community within our school. It is particularly pleasing to read that children are happy at school and that parents value the work of our teaching and support teams.

As a small school, we value feedback and recognise that there are always areas where we can continue to improve. A clear theme within the comments relates to **communication**. Parents have asked for greater notice of some events, clearer information about what children are learning and a simpler way of identifying important dates and actions within our weekly newsletter. We will review this for the new academic year, including making key information and forthcoming dates more prominent and considering when significant events require separate communication.

Parents also raised helpful points about **clubs, trips and enrichment opportunities**. We will continue to review our extracurricular offer, including opportunities for younger children and suggestions such as a drama club. We recognise the importance of ensuring that all classes have access to a broad range of experiences across their time at Sheet, while acknowledging that opportunities will vary according to curriculum content, age, availability and cost.

We are also continuing to strengthen **curriculum communication and online safety education**. Our curriculum information will be reviewed to help parents better understand and support learning at home. Digital literacy and online safety remain important priorities, supported through our curriculum, e-safety policy, regular newsletter updates and parent information.

We have noted individual comments regarding teaching, leadership, recognition of pupils and opportunities for feedback. Anonymous surveys can sometimes make it difficult to explore specific concerns or understand the circumstances behind an individual experience. We would always encourage parents to speak directly with us where they have a concern so that we can listen, understand the context and respond appropriately. All feedback, including feedback that challenges us, is considered carefully.

We are grateful for the many positive comments about our staff and leadership, including recognition of the support provided to individual children, the work of the Robins and Kingfishers teams, and the school's efforts to listen and respond through initiatives such as our recent catering surveys. We will continue to seek parents' views and, where changes are practical and in the best interests of our children, act upon them.

Thank you for your continued support. **Sheet Primary School is a small school with a committed staff team and a wonderfully supportive community, and we remain focused on our shared aim of *Making a difference for every child*.**
