• Provide a safe, inclusive and welcoming environment where every child is known, valued and supported. • Provide high-quality teaching and a broad, balanced and engaging curriculum so every child can achieve their potential. • Have high expectations while recognising children's individual needs and removing barriers to learning. • Help children develop confidence, independence, positive relationships and strategies to regulate their emotions and be ready to learn. • Keep families informed about school life and their child's learning, progress and wellbeing. • Listen to children and families and work in partnership to resolve concerns. • Fulfil our safeguarding duties, including sharing information with other agencies when this is necessary to protect a child. • Provide opportunities for families to be involved in the life of the school.	• Ensure my child attends school every day unless they are too unwell to attend, arrives on time and is ready to learn. • Ensure my child wears the correct school uniform, including plain black shoes/trainers, and brings what they need for the day. • Let school know promptly about illness, medical changes or home circumstances that may affect my child. • Support regular reading and the school's broader home-learning and life-learning activities. • Attend parents' evenings and work positively with school to support my child's progress and wellbeing. • Communicate respectfully with staff and other families, including face-to-face, by email/Dojo and on social media. • Support safe, age-appropriate and responsible use of technology at home. • Support the school's mobile-phone arrangements: only agreed Year 5/6 pupils may bring a basic 'brick' phone, which must be handed into the office on arrival and collected when leaving. • Model positive phone use by keeping mobile phones away on the school site at drop-off and collection, unless needed for an urgent reason. • Support our allergy procedures, including our no-nuts and no food-sharing expectations.	• Live our school values: Perseverance, Effort, Courage, Kindness and Respect. • Come to school ready to learn and always try my best. • Take pride in my work and look after our school, equipment and environment. • Be kind, polite and respectful to children and adults. • Help other children to feel safe, included and happy at school. • Tell a trusted adult if I am worried, upset or need help. • Use the strategies that help me to feel calm, regulated and ready to learn. • Follow the school rules and make safe choices. • Use technology safely and responsibly and only use websites, games and apps that are right for my age.
